Overdue Monies

Morning Routines

All pupils should be in their appropriate line at the start of the school day. This is 8.40 am for KS2 pupils and 8.45 am for KS1 pupils. This is to allow for children to organise themselves for the school day. Pupils arriving after the class has been taken into school should enter through the KS2 door if they are in KS2 or through the front door if they are in KS1. All doors into school will be closed at 8.50 am and gates will be locked at 9.05 am for safeguarding reasons. Any instances of lateness will be recorded, reasons gathered and monitored.
