# Attendance League

### What Is the Attendance League?

We are running a fun, whole-school "Attendance League" to celebrate great attendance and being on time. Classes compete weekly, earn points, and move around our attendance board to unlock rewards.

### How It Works Each Week

- Each class is matched against another class (see the fixture list on the board).
- The class with the **highest attendance** that week earns **1 league point** and gets to **roll and move on the board** (to roll, the class must be **over 93%** attendance).
- Any class that achieves **over 96%** attendance in the week earns **1 league point**.
- The league table is updated regularly so children can see who is leading.

Our school **attendance target is 96%**.



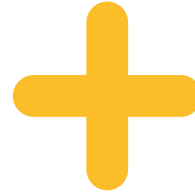
### Why Attendance & Punctuality Matters

- Every day in school builds learning step-by-step. Missing lessons can make children feel behind and less confident.
- Arriving late often means missing key teaching, settling time and important messages - and it can disrupt the class.
- Good routines (sleep, morning prep, punctuality) help children feel calmer and ready to learn.

## Rewards on the Board

As classes move around the board, they can land on rewards such as:

- Dojo points (e.g., 10 Dojos each / 15 Dojos)
- Prize box dip
- Pizza party or pizza in class.
- Early lunch
- Free draw session / board games
- Crazy hair day / class non-uniform day
- Swap-a-teacher session
- Baking, music while working, ChromeBooks, TTRS battle with teachers
- 15 minutes extra play



## End-of-year Prize

The winning class at the end of the year will win an incredible, **money-can't-buy prize!**
